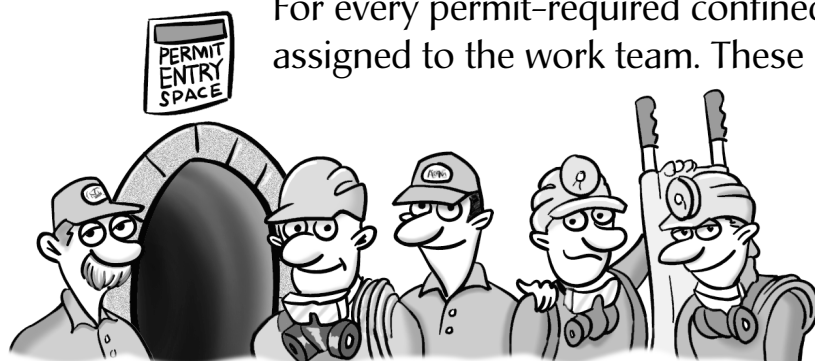


Confined Space Personnel Roles and Responsibilities:

Entrant



For every permit-required confined space entry there are roles assigned to the work team. These include:

- ✓ Entrant
- ✓ Attendant
- ✓ Supervisor
- ✓ Rescue Team

The people in each of these roles must be aware of their duties and be able to perform them in a safe, efficient manner.

The Entrant: Entrants are the people who go into the space to do the work. The entrant is responsible for:

- ✓ knowing the hazards of the space.
- ✓ knowing how to properly use equipment for entry and work in the space.
- ✓ communicating with the attendant and providing the necessary information for the attendant to perform his job.
- ✓ alerting the attendant to any danger or exposure hazards.
- ✓ evacuating the space when told to do so by the attendant or supervisor or in case of danger.
- ✓ always wearing a retrieval device.
