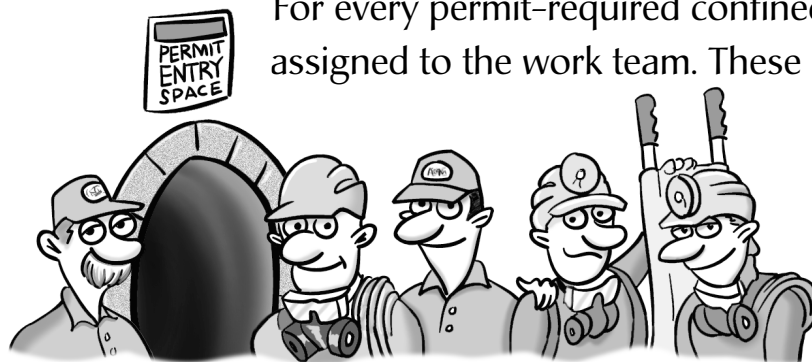


Confined Space Personnel Roles and Responsibilities:

Rescue Team



For every permit-required confined space entry there are roles assigned to the work team. These include:

- ✓ Entrant
- ✓ Attendant
- ✓ Supervisor
- ✓ Rescue Team

The people in each of these roles must be aware of their duties and be able to perform them in a safe, efficient manner.

The Rescue team must: The rescue team is on site in case anything goes wrong within the confined space. The rescue team is responsible for:

- ✓ being trained to the same level as entrants.
- ✓ having a written rescue plan.
- ✓ being trained and able to use any necessary rescue equipment or retrieval systems.
- ✓ being trained and able to use rescue techniques for the permit space.
- ✓ being able to understand the information given to the entrant(s).
- ✓ being trained and able to perform first aid and CPR. At least one member of the rescue team must have current certification.
