Manufacturer's Warning Labels

Chemical container labels are your key to staying safe.

A CHEMICAL WARNING LABEL TELLS YOU...

- \triangle the **name** of the chemical—the common name, the chemical name or both.
- \triangle the **name**, **address and emergency telephone number** of the manufacturer.
- △ the chemical's **physical hazards**—what can happen to you if the chemical isn't handled properly.
- \triangle the chemical's **health hazards**—health problems that can result from overexposure.
- Δ instructions for proper **storage and handling** of the chemical.
- △ basic **protective clothing**, **equipment and procedures** that are needed to work safely with the chemical.

SPECIAL SIGNAL WORDS

IF THE LABEL SAYS:	It Can Cause:
DANGER	immediate serious injury or death
WARNING	potentially serious injury or death
CAUTION	potentially moderate injury

✓ Always...

▲ Read the label and MSDS for every chemical you work with.

▲ Check that every container you use has a label.

- ▲ Report missing or damaged labels so they can be replaced.
- ▲ Put labels on portable containers for all hazardous chemicals.
- ▲ Be familiar with your company's emergency procedures for chemical spills, fires and exposure.

× Never...

- ▲ use a container that isn't labeled.
- ▲ cover labels so they can't be read.
